**RE: FIPPA Access Request #23-223 – Amended Fee Estimate**

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I am responding to your request formally received July 26, 2023 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA), for:

***I would like access to the accepted and denied workplace safety (injuries and occupational illnesses) claim data from 2015 to the present -- broken down by year, industrial category, body part (NAICS codes), etc. -- discussed with Kelly Capone during our July 13, 2023, meeting during which time I outlined exactly what I was looking for. I'm happy to continue the discussion once you have received this request, as we will need a similar meeting craft a more detailed response. So to be clear, I would like to arrange a meeting when you get this request to continue the process of negotiating for data that I used to receive without having to file a formal request.***

**Post Scoping Estimated Cost of Processing Your Request**

In accordance with subsection 57(3) of the FIPPA record(s), the decision-maker shall give the person requesting access a reasonable estimate of any amount that will be required to be paid under this Act that is over \$25.00.

Where the fee is \$100 or more, the fee estimate may be based on a review of a representative sample of the records and/or the advice of knowledgeable institution staff that are familiar with the type and content of the records.

Due to the size, scope, and date range of the request, multiple knowledgeable institution staff have been consulted. As a result of their review and analysis of the type and content of the records and potential records, they were able to provide estimates on the time required to retrieve responsive records.

The cost to provide you with copies of the records is ~~\$510.00~~ \$240.00 and is outlined as follows:

In addition, you must send an appeal fee of \$25.00 to the Commissioner's office. Please include the fee with your letter of appeal; appeal fees should be in the form of either a cheque or money order, payable to the Minister of Finance.
