

The file is slightly different from the 2011\_2006 conversion file to enable quick filtering. All cells in the MET\_NMET\_CODE and CMACA\_NAME fields are populated in the 2016 version, whereas only the first row for each CMA/CA was filled in the 2011 version

The file, CT\_2016\_2011\_conversion\_SRGD.xlsx contains three worksheets. The names and record layouts are described below:

CT 2016 2011

This worksheet contains the complete relationship between the 2016 census tract and its component 2011 census tracts. Note that a 2016 census tract may be comprised of one or more 2011 census tracts. If only part of a 2011 census tract is included in the 2016 census tract, the 2011 code is appended with an asterisk (\*). The record layout is as follows:

| CMACT2011_3   | If applicable, this field identifies the third 2011 census tract, or part there-of, that is included in the 2016 census tract. If only a part is included, an asterisk (*) is appended to the code. It is identified by the concatenation of the 2011 MET_NMET_CODE and the official name of the 2011 census tract included as part of the CMACT2016.  |

newCT 2016 2011

This worksheet contains a list of only those census tracts that are new for the 2016 Census. Note that a 2016 census tract may be comprised of one or more 2011 census tracts. If only part of a 2011 census tract is included in the 2016 census tract, the 2011 code is appended with an asterisk (\*). The record layout is as follows:
