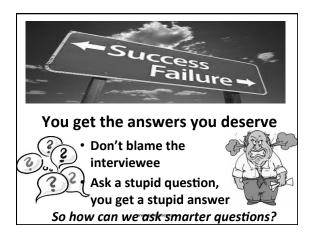

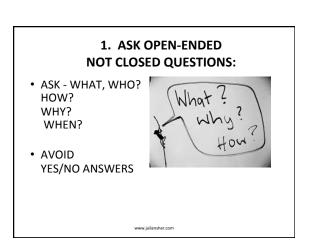

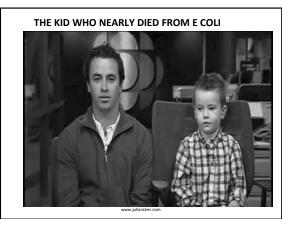

2. DON'T GIVE PEOPLE EASY ESCAPE ROUTES:



- AVOID THE DOUBLE-BARRELLED QUESTION
- THREE WAYS TO LET THEM OFF THE HOOK:

- UNNEEDED FACT

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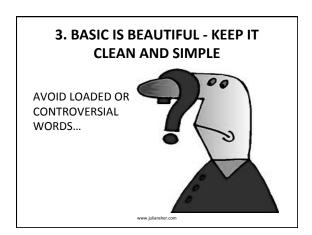


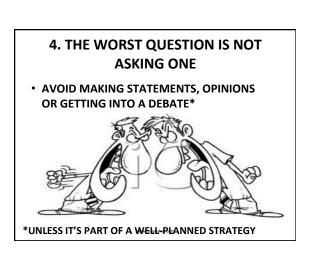


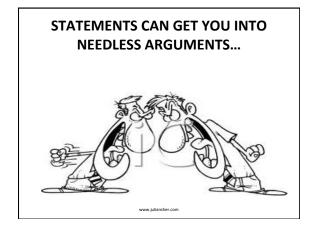

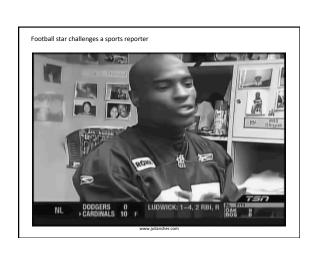
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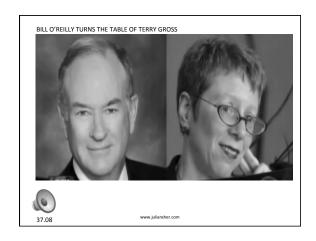






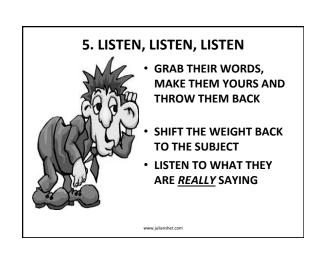














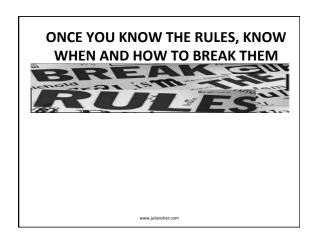


Five Basic Rules of Interviews

- 1. ASK OPEN-ENDED NOT CLOSED QUESTIONS
- 2. DON'T GIVE PEOPLE ANY EASY ESCAPE ROUTES
- 3. BASIC IS BEAUTIFUL KEEP I CLEAN AND SIMPLE
- 4. THE WORST QUESTION IS NOT ASKING ONE
- 5. LISTEN, LISTEN, LISTEN

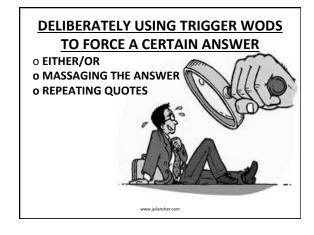
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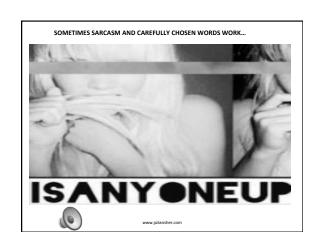


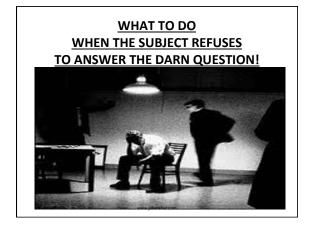

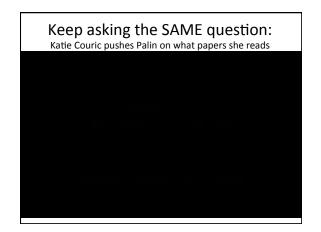


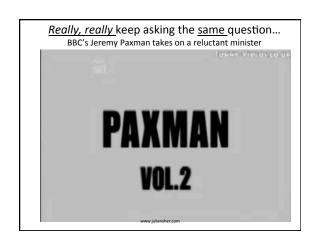
















WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE NO INTERVIEW ??????

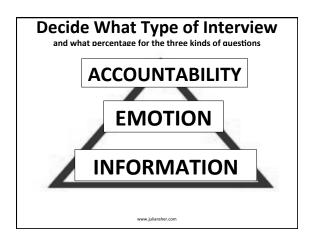
- ◆Be open, forthright. Don't lie or sweet talk
- ◆ Build the ladder of allegations, giving the subject more and more reasons to worry about your investigation
- ◆ Surround the subject (getting to friends, colleagues, enemies)
- Make it clear the story is quite strong without him/her



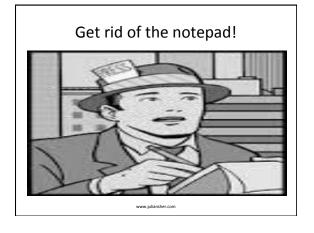


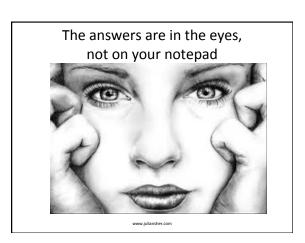
STRATEGY AND PLANNING – PREPARING THE INTERVIEW

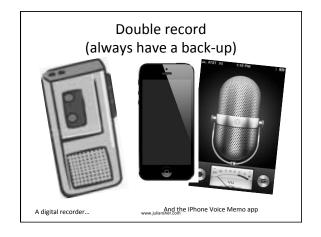
- > DECIDE WHAT TYPE OF INTERVIEW IT WILL BE:
 - > INFORMATION
 - > EMOTION
 - > ACCOUNTABILITY
- > DECIDE WHEN TO DO THE INTERVIEW:
- ➤ **COCOONING** EYE CONTACT, CREATING A SAFE SPACE
- > 'SPYING' WHAT CAN YOU OBSERVE ON THE DESK, WALLS, HOME THAT YOU CAN USE TO DIG DEEPER INTO WHO THAT PERSON IS
- > STORY TELLING: MAKE YOUR INTERVIEWS PART OF YOUR STORY TELLING STRUGAUREner.com











OUTSIDE CRITICS

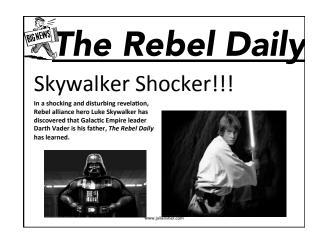


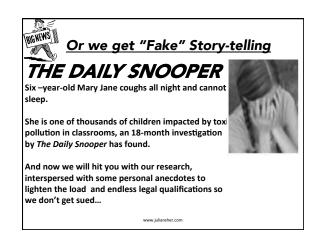






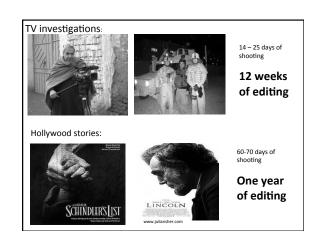
